Annual Winter Retreat

Each Winter, the Town Council holds a retreat with the Manager and Department Heads to highlight accomplishments from the previous year, discuss current projects status, and set a wide range of priorities and budget direction for the coming fiscal year. This year's retreat was held January 29th-31st at the Blowing Rock Conference Center.

2024 - HIGHLIGHTS:

- Main Street* water and sewer project - finished on time and under budget, the town was able to utilize the available budget to complete Maple Street and 221 water and sewer line replacement.
- AMI Water Meters* - the Town completed the installation of all new AMI water meters in 2024. These new meters will save time and money for the town and customers, as they are uploading water usage in real time allowing for leaks to be detected sooner and usage to be known.
- Childcare Center* - opened in March 2024, great success in retention and recruiting, currently working with Duke University and General Assembly on ways to duplicate it.
- Construction and Restorations* - Laurel Lane median and light work, Spillway work including the rebuilding of the failing wall, Chestnut Sewer installed - all completed.
- Financials* - the Town was able to move past Helene in better shape than most of our neighbors. The Town is still on budget projection through mid-year.

2025 - COMING UP:

- Memorial Park Phase 2* - Beginning this month, Phase 2 will include new tennis courts, new volleyball court, new pickleball courts with the conversion of the basketball courts to a better surface, new picnic shelter, new sidewalks along Wallingford, new entrance into the park off Wallingford, shuffleboard and a climbing wall.
- Main Street* - NCDOT paving will take place later this year and then new brick paver crosswalks will be installed once the paving is completed. The Town will start in March/April with a new brick paver crosswalk on Sunset as well, at the BR School entrance.
- Sidewalks* - approximately \$750K of sidewalk repairs will take place over the next 12-18 months - McGill completed a full sidewalk assessment to determine the needs and priority.
- Streets and Paving* - approximately \$750K of street paving will take place over the next 12-18 months - street assessments were completed by McGill to determine the next roads to be paved this coming year.
- Employee Housing* - a local bill will be introduced into the General Assembly in 2025 to allow for the town to explore options for employee housing.

2026 - AND BEYOND:

- Water Line Replacement* - the Town is planning on prioritizing the next round of water line replacements beyond 2026.
- Sewer Line Expansion* - the Town explored and prioritized three areas for possible sewer line expansion, Chestnut Circle, Country Club, and Mayview are all being evaluated.
- Streets and Paving* - the next large round of street paving will take place after 2026. McGill conducted a full street assessment and determined which roads are in need next and a timeline.
- Water Tank and Reservoir* - the Town is also evaluating the capacity of the town's reservoir along with exploring options for a second finished well for storage of finished water.

MEMORIAL PARK: PHASE 2 BEGINS

March 2022, the Town of Blowing Rock was awarded a Parks & Recreation Trust Fund (PARTF) grant in the amount of \$500,000 for Memorial Park improvements which must be matched by the Town and construction must be completed within a specific time frame. The tentative start to Phase 2 is mid to late March.

You will notice temporary construction areas within Memorial Park and we greatly appreciate your patience as we make improvements to our park. We will do our best to communicate construction areas and updates as quickly as possible through emails, on our website and Facebook page.

Currently, this is what to expect starting this month:

- There will be a partial road closure and one way traffic patterns on Wallingford (see picture below).
- The sidewalk between the tennis courts and the Police Department/Parks and Recreation Building will be closed.
- The tennis courts will be closed for renovations (this includes postponing tennis and pickleball lessons).
