Crews will be picking up items throughout the week including items such as old white goods, mattresses, box springs, furniture, grills and paint cans (paint in cans must be dry or have cat litter added to absorb the paint). Do not block any ditches or drains when putting out your items to be picked up. **Yard debris (leaves, tree branches) will continue to be picked up on normal zone schedules (check the website or give us a call at 828-295-5200 if you are unsure of your zone).** Please note that if your yard waste pick up is over a truck load there is a \$150.00 charge. Do not block any ditches or drains when putting out your items to be picked up. We are **not** able to pick up propane tanks, construction debris, electronics, roof shingles, tires or pallets. **There is no need to have your name put on a list - we'll pick items up.**
